

Christmas Classic Rules

General Information for Participating Clubs:

- All teams will play 4, 25 Minute Games that are PRE-DETERMINED. There will be 2 minutes between each game.
- Scoring is as follows: 3 points for a win, 0 points for a loss, 1 point for a tie.
 - In case of a tie at end of the four games, tie breakers will be applied in the following order:
 - Head to head
 - Goals ALLOWED
 - Goal differential

PLEASE NOTE TO ENCOURAGE GOOD SPORTSMANSHIP, no scores higher than 8 will be recorded. A maximum of 8 goals will be counted per game per team.

- Games will be officiated by USFHA rated officials. All current indoor rules apply.

Questions regarding rules can be directed to the tournament staff and he or she will direct your questions to our head official on duty that day.

Players of all age groups are required to wear face masks while defending penalty corners.

- If your team is listed first, please wear a LIGHT jersey and shin guard color.
- It is our MISSION to provide both a competitive and learning opportunity for the athletes involved in the event. We will not tolerate any inappropriate behavior that would interfere with this mission.
- Coaches and players are expected to respect officials and opponents with respect. Please make sure that if there are concerns regarding behaviors of opponents or coaches, that we handle it appropriately. Ask to speak with the official on the game and/or find the directors, Julie Owens or Katie Keyes, with your concerns. Appropriate communication is key to resolving any potential conflicts.
- Spectators MUST remain in the appropriate areas (bleachers). This is for safety and appropriate management of the games.
- All participants are REQUIRED to wear the necessary gear for their protection (mouth guard, shin guard, etc.). Additionally, all participants are required to submit A WAIVER prior to ANY competition, the waivers have been provided to all club contacts/ coaches.
- Members of Sun Field Hockey or Oxford Area High School staff are not responsible for any missing personal belongings. We strongly encourage you to keep any and all valuables with you at all times.
